Fiona Stanley Hospital is part of the South Metropolitan Health Service (SMHS) – a hospital and health service network that aims to deliver high-quality and safe health care to people living in Perth’s south metropolitan area.

The SMHS hospital network includes Fiona Stanley, Fremantle and Rockingham General and Murray District hospitals, as well as the Peel Health Campus.

Each of our hospitals are different and don’t provide the same clinical services. The SMHS network of hospitals, including Fiona Stanley Hospital, work closely with our community partners including GPs and population health services to enhance the recovery and rehabilitation process of our patients and clients.

Our services

Fiona Stanley Hospital is a 783-bed hospital offering state-of-the-art medical and surgical services, emergency care and specialist services for adults and children.

We are home to the State Adult Burns Unit, the State Rehabilitation Service, a comprehensive Cancer Centre and a purpose-built mental health unit.

We provide health care services for people living and working in Perth's southern suburbs and specialised services for people across the State.

Our specialist services

State Rehabilitation Service

Fiona Stanley Hospital's purpose-built, 140-bed State Rehabilitation Service provides inpatient and outpatient services for people with:

- spinal cord injuries
- acquired brain injuries
- neurological conditions including stroke
- amputations
- complex trauma

Located next to the main hospital building, the State Rehabilitation Service incorporates gardens and a therapeutic outdoor area designed to enhance patient's experiences.

Cancer Centre

Our dedicated Cancer Centre provides a comprehensive range of services, including:

- oncology
- haematology services
- chemotherapy
- specialised pharmacy
- dedicated breast service

The Cancer Centre has been developed around a private courtyard and offers a separate entrance and drop-off area to provide privacy for patients and carers.

The SMHS network

If the services you require are not available at Fiona Stanley Hospital, then you will be referred or transferred to another hospital or health service that can meet your needs. This may be another facility in our network or elsewhere in Perth, depending on your requirements.

- ▲ **Tertiary hospitals** provide the highest level of care, often treating those with serious injuries or life-threatening conditions.
- ▲ **General hospitals** provide various services across a range of medical specialties to meet broader health needs.
- ▲ **Specialist hospitals** provide specific health care services, such as mental health, aged care, rehabilitation and elective surgery.
- ▲ District hospitals are typically smaller hospitals based in rural areas, and provide a range of medical services for local communities (districts).

Our approach

Our focus is on ensuring you receive the right care, at the right time, in the right place, by the right team.

All of our hospitals and health services work together. As a result, you may receive your health care at more than one hospital or health service. For example, you may receive your initial surgery at a tertiary hospital and your follow-up care at another hospital closer to your home.

Be assured, regardless of the location, you will be referred to the right hospital or health service to meet your needs.
