



## WA Drug Evaluation Panel (WADEP)

### Expression of Interest

WADEP would like to extend an invitation for the following clinicians to join the Panel as voting members:

- Senior Pharmacists representing SCGH (at least one position), RPH (at least one position), general or specialist hospital in Perth Metro area (at least one position)
- Nurse Practitioner (one position)
- Senior Medical prescriber (registrar or consultant) representatives from FSH (at least one position), WACHS (at least one position), general or specialist hospital in Perth Metro area (at least one position)
- Medical Specialists/Generalists (two positions from any HSP)

Interested clinicians are advised to provide a detailed curriculum vitae outlining qualifications and clinical experience, and a brief letter addressing the following points:

- Why you would like to join WADEP
- How your experience and qualifications make you suitable for the role. Where possible, include reference to any Health Technology Assessment experience or related work processes e.g. research, literature reviews, critical appraisals.

### Scope

WADEP will consider all medications which may be listed on the SMF. The scope of the SMF is detailed in the [SMF Governance and Procedures](#). Medicines outside the scope of the SMF fall within the remit of individual hospital and health service medicines governance bodies such as the Drugs and Therapeutics Committee (DTC) or equivalent.

### Membership responsibilities

Members are expected to:

- Contribute to the development and maintenance of the SMF for use within WA public hospitals and health services. This includes but is not limited to:
  - Critically evaluating SMF submissions
  - Maintaining processes for new listings and review of current listings on the SMF
- Seek to ensure the quality use of medications, equity of access, affordability, safety and supply issues are taken into consideration throughout the review process.
- Actively participate in all meetings and decision making.
- Represent the SMF process and governance in practice.

### Meeting Schedule

Frequency: Every 6 weeks or at the discretion of the Chair. Additional out-of-session business is conducted as required.

Time: WADEP Meetings are usually 90 minutes and begin at 3.30pm via Microsoft Teams.
