0709/06 Floating 12th rib syndrome

Q.

What is the correct code to assign for “floating 12th rib syndrome” for which patient receives intercostal block, rectus sheath block and ilio-inguinal block.

A.

The disorder sometimes referred to as floating rib syndrome, and better known as slipped rib syndrome, occurs when a rib becomes dislocated, slipping out of its socket. As the terms are synonymous, follow Alphabetic Index entry:

Slipped, slipping

- rib and assign M89.88 *Other specified disorders of bone, other site.*

DECISION

Floating rib syndrome should be coded to M89.88 *Other specified disorders of bone, other site.*
